Before wishing everyone a safe return to the north as well as a pleasant summer there are a few reminders that we would like to carry over and into the next winter season.

Important: YOUR HOMES WATER CONNECTION: The Lee County Health Dept. requires that all RV's use a white hose for a drinking water connection and a blue/green sewer connection hose. **Any hose coming from your water service must have a vacuum breaker installed including both sides of a "Y" splitter. Removal of a vacuum breaker or adding Y's without breakers shall be a \$250 fine.** Your sewer line must be free of breaks or cracks. Taping is not permitted! Sewer line must fit snugly into sewer connection. You must install a sewer cap upon departure. If Resident breaks a water line and/or water service for any reason additional fees and expenses for the repair may apply.

Upon your departure for the summer, Citrus Park requests that everyone take the necessary steps in removing all outside items. This would include: bird baths & bird feeders (Health Dept. issued violations last summer), clotheslines, tables, chairs, yard tools, bicycles, grills, lawn mowers and any items that could present a danger during our summer storms. **ALL CANOPY TOPS/COVERS MUST BE REMOVED!** If any item should remain outside, Citrus Park will remove and dispose of them. These items will NOT be returned to you!

If you have not done so please make certain that the mailroom has your correct forwarding address and that you have provided sufficient mailing labels for all your forwarding needs.

In **ALL** sections of Citrus Park:

- If you are planning on renting your home next season please be sure that all necessary information is completed **PRIOR** to renter occupancy. Most importantly it is a mandatory requirement that the homeowner checks-in and checks-out (in person) at the administration office. This will help validate to management that your unit is not solely utilized for rental income. Your occupancy this 2016/17 winter will be taken into consideration for rental approvals for the next 2017/18 season. Simply coming here to open and close your unit for the anticipated renter arrival is not acceptable!! Citrus Park understands that at times renting your home becomes necessary due to medical reasons, financial reasons and family circumstances. However, rentals and rental prices have superseded some of these special circumstances. Citrus Park has heard from many of the non-renting residents of these violations and we will be more critical of the rentals taking place in our community.
- When you sell your home, make certain that you provide the new owners with your mailbox key **AND** give your **I.D. badges to the new tenant or return to the administration office!**

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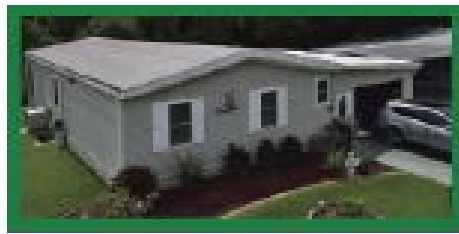
Donny B's Lawn Care

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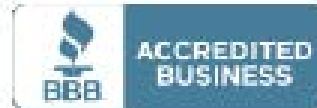
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
